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## **Reston Planned Residential Community District (PRC) Zoning Ordinance Amendment**

RESTON, VA -- Supervisor Cathy Hudgins announces that Fairfax County Zoning Administration Division will discuss proposed Zoning Ordinance Amendments to the Reston Planned Residential Community District (PRC) at two meetings in May:

- Wednesday, May 3, 2017, at 7:00 pm - Open Community Meeting
- Monday, May 15, 2017, at 7:30 pm - Reston Planning and Zoning Committee

The two meetings will provide greater opportunity for community dialogue. Both meetings will be held at the North County Governmental Center – Community Room, 1801 Cameron Glen Drive, Reston, VA.

Based on recommendations from a 40-member community task force, Fairfax County updated the Comprehensive Plan for Reston in 2014 and 2015. The adopted Comprehensive Plan calls for future growth to be focused around certain areas such as the three (3) Metro Stations. The current Zoning Ordinance limits residential density in the PRC District to 13 persons per acre overall. An update to the Zoning Ordinance is needed to accommodate implementation of the adopted Comprehensive Plan, including to the persons per acre limitation on residential development.
